Judgment given in material lawsuit against EGL

The Environmental Group Limited (ASX: EGL) is pleased to announce that today the Federal Court ruled to dismiss claims made against it by former CEO Peter Bowd under the *Fair Work Act 2009*. Final orders are expected to be made in the coming week.

Throughout this long-running process, EGL has maintained that Mr Bowd's termination was both lawful and necessary, and that Mr Bowd had already received all the benefits due to him under his contract of employment.

Despite the existence of litigation, EGL's business has significantly improved over the intervening period, with major acquisitions in an innovative water treatment technology, Baltec Australia, and Tomlinson Energy Services. As noted in last year's Annual Report, the Board expects to generate strong revenue and profit in the coming year.
