- Ensure you use all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and it is fit for purpose, and maintained in a safe working order;
- Use all appropriate safety equipment provided by EGL for your own protection;
- Ensure that newly purchased, loaned, or hired electrical equipment is tested and tagged by a competent person. Any privately-owned electrical equipment must be tested and tagged before being used on EGL sites.
- Work in a manner that ensures your own and other employees' safety;
- Immediately report and secure hazards, cease unsafe work practices and report all incidents; and

Ensure that you advise your supervisor/manager if you feel that the assigned task cannot be performed safely or if you feel your health & wellbeing is being compromised through your work activities (EGL\_PRO\_HSEQ\_003 Comm Consul Participation). This policy applies to all activities undertaken or controlled by EGL.
